### **Year 11 Post 16 Information Evening– Monday 9<sup>th</sup> October 2017- 6pm**

As Year 11 approach their final months with us, it is time to start looking at where students will be going when they leave Cambourne Village College. The government now requires that all young people continue in education or training until at least their 18<sup>th</sup> birthday.

I would therefore like to invite you and your son/daughter to an evening to find out more about the Post 16 transition process and opportunities in the Cambridge area. This will also be an opportunity for you to meet representatives from Sixth Form colleges across Cambridge, Apprenticeship Providers and Businesses with Apprenticeship routes in them.

Students will bring College prospectuses and other information home on Wednesday 4<sup>th</sup> October; please read through each prospectus and mark any courses that are of interest. Students should bring this bag of prospectuses with them on the evening and a list of questions they would like to ask the Colleges. In their bags they will also have a print out of their predicted grades to enable them to make informed choices about the courses they can access. Again, this will be explained in more detail on the evening.

The evening will explain more about how to use this site and the vital part it will play in the application process for all students.

There will be a presentation in the main school hall at 6.00pm; the hall will be open from 5:45pm. After this presentation there will be an opportunity to visit the representatives from individual Sixth Form Colleges and Apprenticeship Providers to ask any questions you have. There will also be a number of senior staff on hand to answer any questions throughout the evening.
