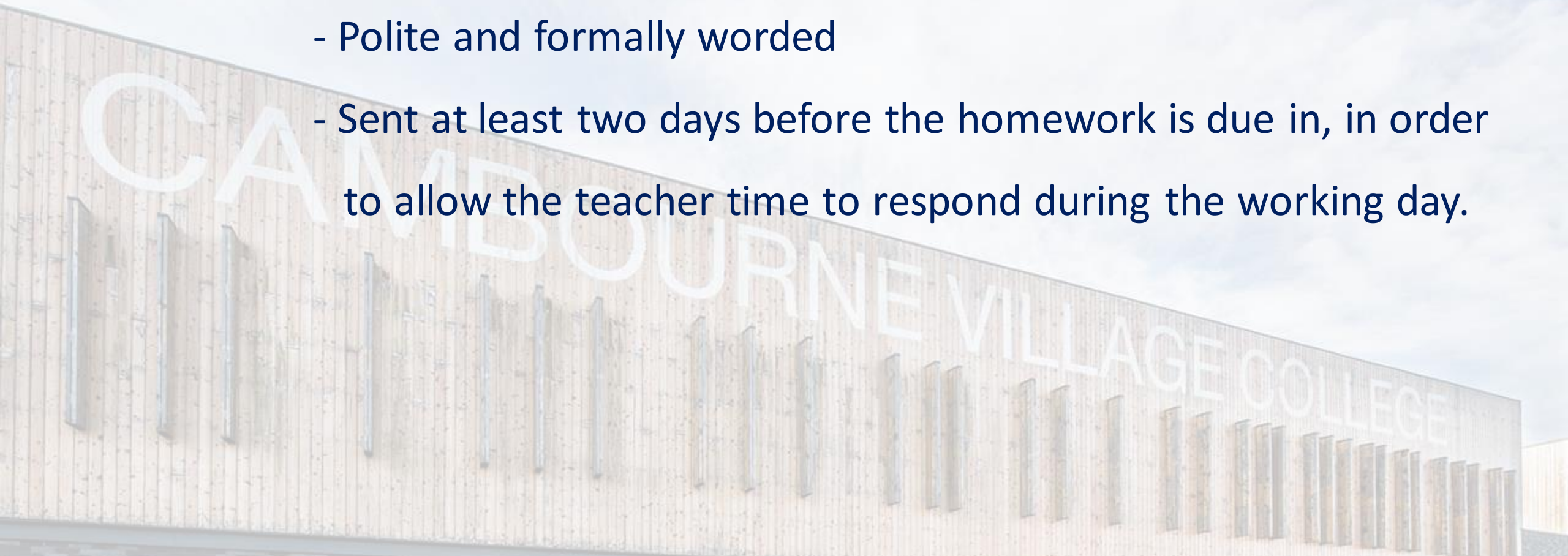


# Homework

- The Library is open every afternoon after school. All pupils are able to attend, and staff are present to support pupils. IT facilities are also available.
- We recommend that pupils take advantage of these facilities in order to complete their homework, especially if they know that they may have issues with internet access, do not have a working iPad, or simply feel like they need the extra support.

- If a pupil fails to complete homework to an acceptable standard **or does not bring it to the lesson by the deadline, even if it has been done and left at home**, the pupil will be placed in Homework Support for one hour after school.
- If there is a reason why a pupil cannot attend the Homework Support Detention on that afternoon, **the parent or carer must communicate with the College as soon as possible after receiving this text message**, so that the Homework Support can be rearranged for the following school day.

- Pupils may email staff to ask for support with homework. Any such requests must be:
  - Polite and formally worded
  - Sent at least two days before the homework is due in, in order to allow the teacher time to respond during the working day.

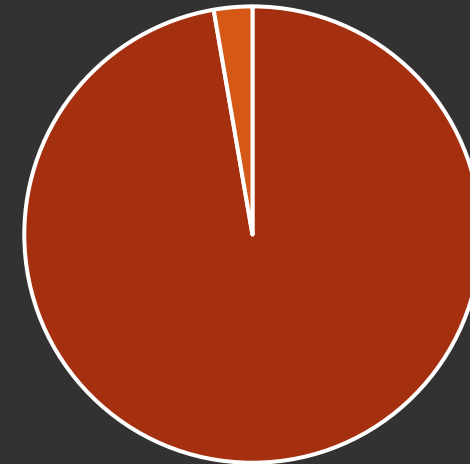

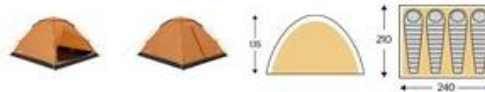

**Top tips for packing:**

- Think about what you will wear each day - don't bring too much stuff (tents are small)
- **NAME everything**
- Bring extra plastic bags (wet stuff/dirty stuff)
- Check the weather beforehand and adapt your packing accordingly
- Pack into a soft bag and not a wheeled suitcase (if possible)
