PUBLIC EXHIBITION 13th September 2018

Cambridgeshire County Council is pleased to announce the development of proposals to expand Cambourne Village College.

As you aware Cambourne is a growing community. The Council has been working with the The Cam Academy Trust to determine how best to provide extra places in permanent accommodation. Late 2017, the Council approved proposals for significant capital investment to expand the existing Cambourne Village College by 2FE (300 pupils).

The Council has appointed Kier Construction to undertake the associated design and build project.

The project is at an early stage and our team is working in consultation with Council officers and their technical advisors to develop the outline proposals in greater detail. Key factors which will influence our approach and the final plans are: ensuring pupils and staff are not placed at any risk and minimising the impact on the day-to-day activities of the school whilst the works are being carried out.

We also recognise the importance and value of consulting with the local community and would very much welcome your views on the outline plans as part of the ongoing development of the scheme, ahead of submission of a formal planning, which is currently scheduled for early October 2018.

On **Thursday 13th September**, a public exhibition of the plans is being held at **Cambourne Village College**. This event will commence at **3:00pm**, and will conclude at **7:00pm**.

Council officers, Kier and the Architects, Frank Shaw Associates, will be pleased to discuss the design proposals with you and would welcome any comments that you may have.

If you are unable to attend the exhibition itself, we would still very much like to hear from you. The draft proposals will therefore remain at the school after the event and be available for public viewing after 5pm weekdays or between 10.00am & 4.00pm at weekends until 27th September, along with a comments box to capture any further feedback.
