

## Post-16 applications: Summary of guidance to students after GCSE results (Summer 2023)

Students not achieving their offer grades should talk to their school first.

### **Bishop Laney Sixth Form**

Students holding offers with Bishop Laney should upload their results and confirm their place via our online process, the link to which will be provided to Offer Holders in July. Anyone with queries may call 01353 652818 once they have their results to discuss their place between 9:30am and 2:30pm. Those whose results mean they need a further discussion will be invited to book a guidance meeting appointment later on Thursday 24<sup>th</sup> August or Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August morning. The majority of which will be online, though on-site appointments will also be available. Students who wish to discuss a late application or to reinstate an offer, should contact 01353 652818 on Thursday from midday, or between 10am and 2pm on Friday. ### **College of West Anglia**

All applicants will be expected to upload a photo of their grade sheet to our student portal. This will allow us to confirm that the applicant has met the entry requirements for their course and complete their enrolment. There's no need to contact us separately – applicants just need to upload the grades and we'll take it from there. If an applicant doesn't meet the entry requirements for the course, we will contact them to discuss their options. In most instances, we'll be able to offer an alternative level for their chosen course. ### **Comberton Sixth Form**

Students will receive information that explains how to electronically confirm GCSE their results and confirm their place. ### **Hills Road Sixth Form College**

In July, all students who have been made an offer will receive instructions about the enrolment process, including how to **submit their exam results via the enrolment platform by 1pm on Thursday 24 August**.

There is no need for applicants to contact the College before enrolment.

**For the majority of students, enrolment will take place online.** Applicants will be required to complete a two-stage process:

- **Stage one:** upload their exam results sent/given to them by their school and their photograph.
- **Stage two:** once the College has reviewed their exam results, they will receive an email that will explain how to complete stage two enrolment.

If an applicant's results do not meet the entry criteria for their chosen course, they will be emailed by the College on Friday 25 August with an appointment to attend enrolment at Hills Road on either **Tuesday 29 or Wednesday 30 August**. Applicants will be invited to discuss, with the College's A level specialists, whether or not an offer of a place can be confirmed and in which subjects.

If possible, students are advised to keep Tuesday 29 or Wednesday 30 August available, in case we need to discuss their course

### **Impington International College**

All students holding offers will need to upload their results by **1pm on 24<sup>th</sup> August, via MyChoice or Applicaa**. All applicants will be sent information well in advance outlining the enrolment process in detail. There will be an opportunity for students who do not meet their offer to discuss their situation with one of our Heads of Programme on the 25<sup>th</sup> August.

### **Long Road Sixth Form College**

All students who hold an offer with us will be sent instructions in July about the enrolment process, including how and when to submit their exam results.

**Exam results will need to be submitted via their #MyLongRoad accounts by no later than 1pm on Friday 25<sup>th</sup> August.** Students can expect to receive offers from 25<sup>th</sup> August onwards. Students will be given the opportunity to request an enrolment meeting (conducted via telephone) to discuss their course options. Those who **do not meet the entry requirements for their original choices, will automatically be invited to a telephone meeting** to discuss alternative courses that they *are* qualified to study, *wherever possible*. Meetings will be scheduled across the 30<sup>th</sup> and 31<sup>st</sup> August, therefore we ask students to make themselves available for those dates.

Once the enrolment offer has been accepted, students will receive IT onboarding instructions to be completed online, ahead of orientation.

- **Virtual Student Enrolment:** 30<sup>th</sup> – 31<sup>st</sup> August
- **On-site Orientation Days:** 6<sup>th</sup> – 7<sup>th</sup> September
- **All Teaching Starts:** 11<sup>th</sup> September

### **Oakes College**

Students will be sent information regarding enrolment by the end of term and are encouraged to enrol in person. Students will need to bring copies of their GCSE results (or equivalent) with them to the meeting, plus a copy of a passport or equivalent documentation as proof of identity.

### **Abbeygate Sixth Form College**

Enrolment Day 24th August instructions:

Login to your online admissions portal account and complete the enrolment wizard. As part of this process you will need to upload a picture of your GCSE results and an ID Photo. NOTE: We will send more detailed instructions on how to complete this process over the summer holidays.

Once you have completed the Enrolment process, we will update your online admissions portal with details of your next step. We will send you details of your Induction session.

### **West Suffolk College**
