They will also play a key role in the preparation of new resources and practical tasks as we move towards opening a sixth form in 2023. Specific responsibilities will include:

- Preparing and providing lesson resources and ensuring that systems for delivering these are effective and efficient
- Supporting other technicians in developing their skills
- Preparing new lesson resources for Key Stage 5 teaching
- Taking a lead role in ensuring that health and safety standards are adhered to
- Overseeing the maintenance of science equipment

The successful candidate will be organised and self-motivated, have a high level of accuracy and proficient IT skills. They will enjoy working in a large team and be able to form strong relationships with team members and students. They will be supported in developing their skills and have significant scope to develop their role the lead up to sixth form opening.
